When Pump vs. Non-Pump Programs irrigate:

The ET2000e irrigation controller has certain default settings that make installing and programming very easy. One of them is 'Use of Pump by Program'. The default setting is YES for each of the seven programs. When the controller is installed at a site without pump usage, you don't have to change this default, as it will have no effect on irrigation.

At a site where there is a pump, press **Main Menu > Flow > Pump**. Set each program for pump usage: YES or NO. Also, think of this setting when adding a new controller to a *FLOWSENSE* chain as that is a more complex environment to manage. A *FLOWSENSE* chain consists of multiple controllers sharing a pump, master valve and/or flow sensor. The controller cannot run pump and non-pump programs at the same time; therefore, it could cause a longer than planned irrigation period and less valves to irrigate simultaneously.
