



Tech Tip of the Month

GIS (Geographic Information System)

Command Center Software (COMM-1) now includes a new integrated GIS viewer. The viewer visually represents controllers on a map using your company's existing GIS data. Highly customizable, the map can include site and area details, such as parks and streets, which place your controllers within easily recognizable surroundings.

The GIS viewer displays each controller's status by use of color-coded symbols. As controller Alert Reports are retrieved, these symbols may change to represent real-time controller events, such as:

- Mainline Breaks
- Flow issues, such as high, low, or no flowing valves
- Weather issues, such as rain affecting irrigation or irrigation paused due to high wind
- Electrical issues, such as no currents or output shorts interfering with irrigation
