## Tech Tip of the Month

### Scheduling Days not to Water

Scheduling days not to water is easy with your Calsense controller. There are many reasons to temporarily suspend irrigation: school graduations, painted football fields, mow days, and inclement weather forecast.

Program the controller to suspend scheduled irrigation for one or more days, up to 31 days. This setting called No water days can be applied to a single, multiple, or all programs on the controller; and/or select stations. The ability to target specific stations or programs is convenient if an event is only happening in one area. Regularly scheduled irrigation automatically resumes when the No water days reach zero.

To set up No Water Days, press **Rain Off**. (Water drop with the line through it)

Once set, review the No Water Days summary on a controller by pushing the No Water Days are Set Summary button in the Status screen. You can edit or cancel the number of No Water days at any time.
